What is a Community Heritage Register?



List of historic places in a community with heritage value or character Officially recognized by local government **resolution** Local government planning tool focused on **education**

What a Community Heritage Register is Not



A bylaw, **designation**, or regulation.



A tool to **protect** heritage property.



A way to **limit changes** a property owner may make to their property.

Benefits



- Formal way to identify Smithers' historic places.
- Currently there is no resource available.



SHARE KNOWLEDGE

- Locally, provincially & federally.
- Fills a knowledge gap as many residents, property owners & planners are not aware of property history.



INCLUDE IN TOWN PLANNING

- Town currently makes limited use of available heritage tools (designated two buildings 25 years ago).
- Implement OCP policies related to heritage & reconciliation.

SUPPORT HERITAGE CONSERVATION

- Properties qualify for BCBC
 Alternative Compliance Methods for Heritage Conservation.
- Only available to properties listed in a register.

How will a Register be Developed?



Community Engagement

- Better understand community heritage values.
- Identify historic places to include on the register (what and why).
- An evolving process registers are living documents.

Final report submitted & presented to Smithers Council that contains:



A 'ready to adopt and implement' Smithers Heritage Register



Documents community heritage values based on community engagement



Aligns with LGA & BC Register of Historic Places documentation



Recommends **implementation steps & ideas** on ways the Town can integrate heritage into local planning
